

Student Profiling

Student Profiles are a tool to consider using in this Secondary Intervention stage. They wouldn't be done for every student in the class but they can help ensure consistency of approach for casuals and new staff. Basically profiles are a summary stating the name, age, class, student areas of strength, possible triggers for inappropriate behaviour, a list of strategies that generally work, a list of motivators.

There are many different templates to use in order to gather relevant information. Such as: Analysis and Prompt sheets, Risk Management Plans, ABC charts, Classroom Observation checklists, Scatterplots, School reports, Counsellor reports etc. See Toolbox at the end of this section for examples.
